### Stowe's Green Mountain Inn Celebrating Tradition: Vermont Style

As a member of the Vermont Fresh Network, a non-profit organization linking restaurants with local farmers and food producers, the Inn's special holiday menu features a cornucopia of harvest bounty prepared with regional flair. Daily country breakfasts and two nights lodging complete this getaway experience offered from November 26 - 30.

Seasonal spirit abounds with the Inn's Vermont Christmas Tree package offered as a pre-Christmas holiday escape. Guests choose their own tree from Paine's Christmas Tree Farm in nearby Morrisville to either ship home or take with them. Other package features include a print of "The Christmas Tree" by noted Stowe painter Walton Blodgett or a hand-painted Green Mountain Inn commemorative ornament. The package includes two nights lodging and full country breakfast daily and runs from Nov. 30 - Dec. 21.

The Inn's Christmas in the Village package delivers on the image it conjures of a quintessential Vermont Christmas complete with horse-drawn sleigh ride and holiday dinner at the Inn's Main Street Dining Room. Three nights lodging (or additional nights as requested), full country inn breakfast daily, as well as a holiday ornament are included in the package available for arrival on December 23, 24 or 25.

Located in the heart of picturesque Stowe Village, the Green Mountain Inn has been providing Vermont hospitality to its guests since the mid-1800s. The Inn is listed as Numbers 13 and 14 on the National Register of Historic Places and has hosted such famous visitors as Lowell Thomas, Presidents Chester Arthur and Gerald Ford, Thomas Edison, and Henry Ford.
